Chateau Haut-Monplaisir Prestige Cahors Malbec, 2006

From the region of Cahors where it was famous for making the Black wine of Malbec and Tannat, this is a toned down version of such monoclastic wines. The colour is Garnet with a nose of red fruits, some cherries, chocolates and brambly spices. The palate is generous and still has a youthful acidic and tannin structure. Would suit a Casoulet.
